The work and the life of the Church is an extension of the Mission of God in the world. As believers, we are all called to engage and transform culture for the sake of His kingdom. They operate as if God does not exist or does not matter. They have attempted to overthrow God's moral law and his norms for public life. Human rights are violated continuously—none more so than an unborn being's right to live. Religious liberty continues to come under threat. National corporations reveal their animus toward Bible-believing Christianity.

The gathering storm might tempt us to despair. However, in the midst of the storm, we must remember that our Lord Jesus Christ still rules the world. In an era that is in many ways adamantly opposed to the gospel, we will proclaim that Christ is King, and that the gospel is good news that affects every sector of society and sphere of culture.

Why Coral Ridge?

Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church has a rich history of establishing strong institutions that engage culture with the gospel in ways that lead to genuine results in our community and the world.

Founded in 1960, Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church launched a gospel movement under the leadership of Dr. D. James Kennedy in the midst of dramatic social, cultural, and political upheaval. With the rise of postmodern epistemology and philosophy, the culture moved away from prior commitments to an objective moral and philosophical view of the world. For the first time, truth was up for interpretation and nothing could be taken for granted.

In response to this, Coral Ridge launched Evangelism Explosion, empowering the laity in local communities and throughout the world. Coral Ridge understood that the means to effective ministry begins with normal believers faithfully living their lives in service to others within their own community. Evangelism Explosion fundamentally altered the global Church's overall understanding of

the importance of lay missionary activity and modeled an effective evangelism ministry that has led to the faith commitment of millions of individuals.

In addition to the work of Evangelism Explosion, Coral Ridge recognized the broader aspects of cultural engagement for which the Church is also responsible, and established Westminster Academy and Knox Theological Seminary. In each case, the goal was to equip and train competent individuals for life in a world that is composed of deep biblical knowledge, a strong commitment to personal engagement with faith in the larger community of faith, and a mindset that recognizes all work as an extension of the Church's larger mission.

At Coral Ridge, we believe that cultural institutions are the primary drivers of cultural transformation. With its history of building gospel-centered institutions that have achieved sustained success and longevity in their missions, we believe that the Institute for Faith and Culture is uniquely equipped to meet the challenges of the future.





Why South Florida?

A GLOBAL INFLUENCE

South Florida is a dynamic hub with influence that spreads around the globe. A link between North and South America, South Florida is unofficially nicknamed the "Gateway to the Americas." But despite its growth and influence, South Florida is currently outpacing the rest of the United States in secularization and diminishing Christian identity.

Located at Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church in Fort Lauderdale, the Institute for Faith and Culture is uniquely positioned for cultural renewal in the United States. Fort Lauderdale has become the most diverse city per capita in Florida, and the city is asking questions that Christians must be ready to answer. It is our hope that the Institute will become a hub for innovative approaches to cultural engagement and missional activity and will prepare a generation of leaders to adequately answer these questions.

A CHURCH IN CAPTIVITY

According to both Pew Research Center and The Barna Group, the next 30 years will represent the largest missions opportunity in the history of

America and particularly in South Florida. As trends have already demonstrated, Christian affiliation within the United States has significantly decreased.

Barna discovered that South Florida is one of the most unchurched regions in the country. Only three percent of Broward County, Florida, residents meet the criteria of being a committed Christ follower. These are individuals who believe:

- 1. Jesus Christ lived a sinless life on earth
- 2. The Bible is accurate in all that it teaches
- 3. They will go to heaven when they die
- 4. Eternal salvation is possible only through grace
- 5. Faith in Jesus Christ shapes every area of life
- **6.** They have a personal responsibility to share their beliefs about Jesus Christ with non-Christians

South Florida will soon become a focal point for domestic mission efforts. The question for the Church in South Florida is, "How do we engage culture in such a way to expand the three percent?"

What Will the Institute Provide?

RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT

▶ Conducting research on the state of culture and the Church, equipping leaders to better engage in the marketplace and public square.

▶ Original digital and print resources, aimed at equipping believers and enabling them to engage the broader culture with truth.

▶ Weekly production of the *City of God Podcast*, a podcast dedicated to helping Christians navigate current events from a biblical worldview.

▶ Production of timely videos on culturally relevant topics (i.e., social justice, abortion legislation, the Defund the Police movement, the nuclear family), distributed on various social media channels to reach the next generation around the nation.

EVENTS

▶ National and regional conferences with world-class speakers aimed at equipping Christians for cultural engagement.

▶ **Seminars** that provide the Christian community with detailed biblical analysis and response to current moral, political, and cultural controversies (i.e., Critical Race Theory, parental rights, religious liberty, biblical worldview of gender and sexuality).

▶ The Institute headquarters (pictured below) will be equipped with six meeting rooms for in-person classes, seminars, and recording of content. Work stations will be utilized by interns and fellows. A resource center will provide original content throughout the week and for special events and conferences.

PUBLIC SQUARE ENGAGEMENT AND TRAINING

In partnership with the Center for Christian Statesmanship in Washington, DC, we will:

▶ Host conferences and seminars that focus on the importance and the integration of faith and politics.

► Conduct onsite and online leadership training, designed to equip the next generation of Christian leaders in government.

▶ **Sponsor forums and resources** that bring awareness to the public policy issues concerning the Faith Community—at the local, state, and national levels.

NEXT GENERATION LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

▶ Three-month college internship for Christian students looking to make an impact outside of traditional ministry.

▶ Nine-month graduate fellowship, teaching young leaders to live a public faith in their career and beyond.

► Classes preparing high school students to live out their Christian faith on a college campus.

COURSES AND CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS (onsite and online)

Our offerings are broken into three main categories:

1. BIBLICAL KNOWLEDGE (story) – These courses equip the Christian to fully understand the metanarrative and themes of Scripture. The unity of the storyline gives us a foundational framework to understand God and His ultimate purpose in the world.

2. BIBLICAL COMPETENCY (worldview) – These courses equip the Christian to understand the theological truths that arise from the sacred text and then learn how to apply them to all of life. This is biblical worldview development.

3. BIBLICAL INFLUENCE (mission) – These courses equip the Christian to practically shape culture and live life on mission for the kingdom of God.
