

The Bible says, "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

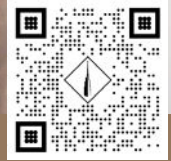
YOU CAN PRAY THIS SIMPLE PRAYER:
