#### THE PRESENCE OF CHRIST IN COMMUNION

The Lord Jesus is spiritually and really present when believers celebrate communion. The spiritual presence of Christ in the Supper is part and parcel of His promise to be with His people wherever they may be.

When assembled for the work of the church, even though only two or three are present, He will be in their midst (Matt. 18:20). Indeed, Jesus' presence will be with His people until the end of the age (Matt. 28:20). Through the ministry of the Holy Spirit, Christ dwells within His people (Gal. 2:20; cf. 1 Pet. 1:11).

This spiritual presence of Christ is not, however, any less real to the believer. Jesus' presence isn't just a theological concept, a thought that is with us for as long as we think it. The Lord is really with His people.


