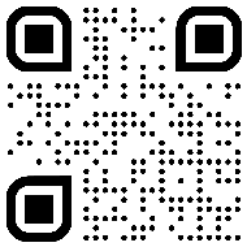

UNDERSTANDING CHAPTERS 40-66

The Messianic theme continues into the second major section of Isaiah where the prophet is now called to address two different historical contexts far removed from his own lifetime. In chapters 40-55, the Lord speaks to the Judean exiles with the promise of their sure return home (605-539 BC), and in Isaiah 56-66, he speaks to those who have now returned to the land and are awaiting the arrival of the Messianic age (539-500 BC). Our upcoming study will pick up with the second major section of Isaiah. In chapters 40-66, we will be given a firsthand look at the Messiah, particularly regarding his representative mission as the Servant of the Lord and the results of his saving work. In view of this, Isaiah Part Two is aptly entitled *Salvation Through the Lord's Servant*.
