# PASTOR'S GREETING


Thank you for joining us for worship today!

We are so glad you're here!



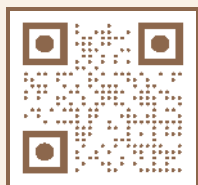
