To approve the following by the Corporation, Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church, Inc, (Westminster Academy, a wholly owned ministry of the Corporation, is directly affected by the proposed transaction): (a) purchase of a 48-year land lease for a 4-acre property located adjacent to Westminster Academy for use by the Corporation; (b) contemporaneous borrowing of \$17 million to fund the acquisition of the land lease and construction-related expenses associated with both the current and future church and school properties, and (c) the related granting of a collateral interest (i.e. mortgage) to the lender in (i) the purchased leasehold interest and (ii) real estate consisting solely of the Westminster Academy west campus.
