# EASTER SUNDAY GREETING


**W**elcome to Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church. We are so glad that you are worshiping with us.

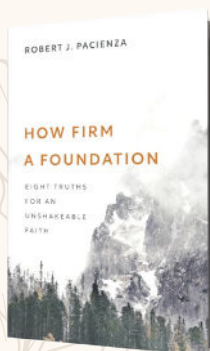
