Kingdom Citizens in a Corinthian World

In anticipation of our upcoming Fall study, join us over the summer months as we prayerfully begin reading Paul's first epistle to the Corinthians.

The apostle Paul wrote 1 Corinthians out of deep fatherly concern in response to a report he received about several distortions within the church at Corinth—distortions that were rooted in mistaken views of the gospel, the work of the ministry, and the nature of the Christian life. These mistaken views were undergirded by a spirit of worldliness that had been allowed to infiltrate the church and was tempting the Corinthians to follow the way of the world rather than the way of the cross. In God's providence, 1 Corinthians not only speaks to the needs of Christ's Church during the first century, but it also speaks to the church throughout every century, challenging the people of God to live as kingdom citizens in the midst of a Corinthian world.

This plan identifies 12 predominate themes in 1 Corinthians chapters 1-7. Each week will highlight the particular theme, with daily readings of supporting scripture from both the Old and New Testaments.
