PASTOR'S GREETING



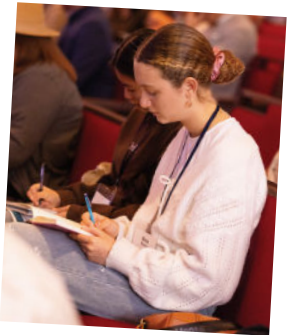
